Travel Information:

From New Jersey Turnpike, North or South:

Take exit 15W to I-280 West to the Orange St./6th St. exit. Make a right onto Orange St. and proceed one block to First St. Turn right and proceed about half a mile to West Market St., where First St. becomes Bergen St. Proceed two traffic lights and make a left onto South Orange Ave. Go one traffic light and make a left into parking lot #1.

From The Garden State Parkway, North or South: Take exit 145 to I-280 East. Stay to the left to Exit 13-First St. Turn right on First St. and continue across five traffic lights. At the fifth traffic light, make a left onto So. Orange Avenue. Proceed one traffic light make a left into the medical school parking lot #1.

From Route 78, East or West (From Newark International Airport, use Route 78 Westbound): Take Exit 56, Clinton Ave/Hillside exit. Proceed on Hillside Ave. until you have reached the end. At this point you can only turn left. Make the left and get into your right lane. Make the right turn onto Irvine Turner Blvd. Go to the seventh traffic light and make a left. You are now on South Orange Ave. Proceed to the next traffic light and make a right into parking lot #1.

From New York City: Take the George Washington Bridge or the Lincoln Tunnel to NJ Turnpike to Exit 15W. Follow directions from the NJ Turnpike. Or take the Holland Tunnel to NJ Turnpike to Exit 14 to Route 78 W. Follow directions from Route 78W.

Parking:

Upon arriving on campus, please try to find a space in lot #1 (185 So. Orange Ave) or the parking deck (entrance on Norfolk St). If you use the Norfolk parking deck, proceed to Level A (street level) follow the signs to the medical school entrance. Do not park in "Reserved," "Guaranteed" or metered parking areas.
