## Ilizarov Adjustments (for Clicker rods)

- The rod to be adjusted will be marked by a numbered piece of tape with an arrow to show direction of adjustment.
- The head of the clicker is square, and each face represents  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn. The face may be marked with nail polish for a reference point.

## PROCEDURE

- 1. Depress the locking bar to initiate the turn.
- The clicker itself has 4 faces. Turn the clicker in the direction of the arrow 2. the desired number of turns. For example  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn would be one face;  $\frac{1}{2}$  turn would be 2 faces on the clicker. Every  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn is equal to  $\frac{1}{4}$  mm (0.25mm). Therefore 4 turns (clicks) = 1.0 mm
- 3. If the clicker is difficult to turn, it may be necessary to use a 19 mm wrench to complete the turn.
- 4. After completing the turn, the clicker should lock into place with a faint click sound. Be sure the locking bar is in the locked position.
- 5. Use the attached flow sheet to keep track of adjustments.
