

DISCLOSURE STATEMENT: CONSUMER REPORT OR INVESTIGATIVE CONSUMER REPORT

Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey and its designated agents and representatives may arrange for a consumer reporting agency to conduct a comprehensive review of your background through a consumer report and/or an investigative consumer report to be generated for the purpose of evaluating your employment, promotion, reassignment or retention as an employee or a condition of my volunteer service.. This consumer report or investigative consumer report may include, but is not limited to, the following areas: social security number verification; credit reports; criminal records checks; court records checks; driving records; professional licensing; professional liability claims history; charges of research misconduct; information about your character, mode of living, general reputation and personal characteristics; and/or summaries of educational and employment records and histories. Any information contained in these reports may be taken into consideration in evaluating your suitability for employment.

To the extent that Rutgers requests an investigative consumer report, which generally provides information about your character, your general reputation and personal characteristics, your mode of living, summaries of your educational and employment records and histories, you will receive separate disclosure of the precise nature and scope of the report and, if you request, you will receive a copy of the report.
