






The Graduate Student Association Announces the

Thursday, October 27, 2016



This year's plenary talk will be given by Dr. Kent Hunter, a Senior Investigator in the Laboratory of Cancer Biology and Genetics at the NIH. Using innovative strategies and cutting edge technologies he has identified a number of genes that contribute to inherited susceptibility to tumor dissemination. Dr. Hunter continues to pioneer the use of integrated genetic and genomic technologies to gain better understanding of the genes and cellular pathways that contribute to the metastatic process. Recent efforts include incorporating the knowledge gained from the genetic studies with novel therapeutic compounds or strategies to try to reduce metastatic burden in breast cancer patients.
