NEWARK, N.J. — On Friday, March 18, 2016, scores of fourth-year Rutgers New Jersey Medical School (NJMS) students participate in the school's Match Day festivities. Match Day is an annual event when thousands of fourth-year medical students in the US learn the residency programs they will begin in the fall.

Intense drama awaits several students who are hoping they "match" with programs of their choice. At the event, students will be handed sealed envelopes that contain information about where they will have their first jobs as physicians. NJMS students typically match to top-rated residency programs throughout the country.
