Effective, Fall of 2011, budgets supporting graduate students should include 8% of salary the student health insurance fee (\$2241/year) and the Health Services Fee (\$350/year) in addition to \$28,455 annual graduate student stipend.

**Non-salary Annual Increases: 3%** on non-salary expenses (non-NIH)

# **Indirect Costs/Facilities and Administrative Costs:**
