We provide services under a one-stop shop model where patients receive primary medical and specialty care (Hepatology, gynecology, anal cancer screening and psychiatry), medical case management, other services (financial counseling, case management, mental health and substance abuse counseling and treatment and support groups) and HIV testing. We work with all people regardless of their sexual orientation, race or ability to pay.

About Rutgers NJMS: Celebrating its 60th anniversary, NJMS was founded in 1954 and is the oldest school of medicine in NJ. Today it is part of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey and graduates approximately 170 physicians a year. In addition to providing the MD degree, the school offers MD/PhD, MD/MPH and MD/MBA degrees through collaborations with other institutions of higher education. Dedicated to excellence in education, research, clinical care and community outreach, the medical school comprises 21 academic departments and works with several healthcare partners, including its principal teaching hospital, The University Hospital.
