Founded in **1970** by the State Legislature as the College of Medicine & Dentistry of New Jersey; granted University status in 1981.

4 main campuses: Newark, Stratford, Camden, Piscataway/New Brunswick; branch campus: Scotch Plains.

8 schools, plus Newark's University Hospital and University Behavioral HealthCare.

185 acres, **59** buildings, **6.3** million square feet \$535 million building expansion program started in 2000 to add 1.7 million square feet to academic and research facilities.

Largest institution of its kind in the nation.
