

Systems Based Practice

Goals and Objectives

To educate the resident in the application of SBP principles via multiple common scenarios encountered in anesthesia practice

- 1) This will be accomplished by the investigation of a specific subject by a team of 3-4 members leading to a poster presentation.
- The posters will be judged by an expert panel. The best being awarded points toward prize. The best 2-3 posters being presented at a special departmental Grand Rounds(all posters will be presented to the faculty).
- 3) For the best and most suitable poster will be prepared for submission to be at local or national meetings or expanded into potential publications.
- 4) Judges will be chosen from both inside and outside the department.
- 5) A topic list will be made available and teams in place by late October. A team progress report will be due 12/15 with a poster submission date of March 1st.
- 6) Teams will use multiple methods to research their areas and will come from traditional as well as non-traditional sources including but not limited to the medical and non-medical literature, experts, policy manuals, government agencies, and other source that seems appropriate.
- 7) In addition, working in teams will reassert the cooperative nature of medical activities and systems. Presentation of a poster for a national meeting and demonstration of public presentation skills are added goals to this project.
